#### **Wai Connection Unit**

At the end of last year Nicky Toothill from the Taranaki Regional council visited us to deliver the "Introduction to Freshwater" unit as part of the Wai Connection program. To extend on our Freshwater unit, Thursday last week Whaea Nicky and Whaea Clare brought samples from the Pātea river in Stratford and also from the river here in Pātea. Our tamariki learnt that The Pātea River in Stratford and the Pātea River in Pātea are both part of the same river system, but they flow through different regions in Taranaki. They were able to compare the samples and observe the differences in life within the river. They noted a big difference in the temperature and come to the conclusion that Stratford is closer to the mountain, which is where the Pātea River starts.
